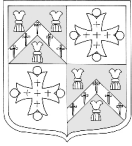

Also, there was a report from Smith of Derby for work to be undertaken on the Town Hall Clock

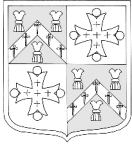
605/2020 **10. UPDATE ON CLUN CASTLE**

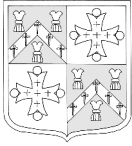

The town was walked with a consultant and a report will be forthcoming

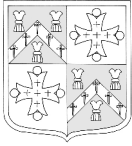
